Music and Dancing

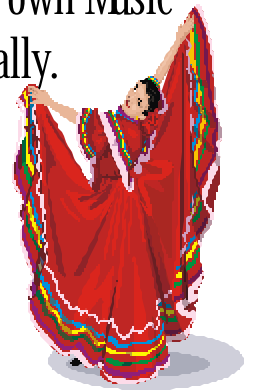
Ms. Viv will dress up in her authentic dance outfit from Puerto Rico and teach the children the "Salsa" and the "Bomba"
